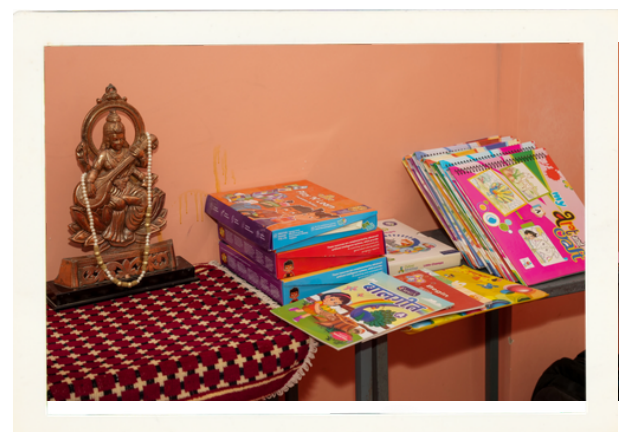

# Strengthening Healthcare

## *In Partnership with Friends of Max*

For the past 23 years, Friends of Max (FOM) has been working to support patients living with Chronic Myeloid Leukaemia (CML) and Gastrointestinal Stromal Tumour (GIST), two rare cancers requiring lifelong treatment and regular disease monitoring.

Through this partnership, we have successfully implemented a pan-India initiative that facilitated essential BCR-ABL and CBC testing of patients directly from their homes at no cost to them.

The project addressed one of the most critical barriers faced by CML patients, that is, access to affordable and reliable diagnostic monitoring.

By reducing both financial and logistical burdens, the collaborative effort ensured continuity of care, improved treatment compliance and enhanced cancer outcomes.

# Project Impact and Outcomes:

The program ensured:

- Home sample collection and issuance of online reports on WhatsApp
- Quality-assured BCR-ABL and CBC testing through a NABL certified diagnostic lab partner
- Pan-India reach including Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3 and remote regions
- Timely reporting for physicians and patients
- Zero financial burden on patients



Geographic Reach: The initiative reached patients across multiple states including Tamil Nadu, Assam, Telangana, Maharashtra, Puducherry, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Kerala, Punjab, Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Haryana, West Bengal, Jammu & Kashmir, Tripura, Delhi
